Marguerite Frances Reed Butler age 95 of Guin, AL passed away
Wednesday, August 28, 2019 at her residence.

Born August 9, 1924 in Rome Georgia, she is the daughter of the late Charles O. and Mettie Jerusha Hicks Reed and the wife of Thomas Gilbert Butler.

She grew up in Rome, Georgia. She obtained a B.A. History, from Shorter College in Rome, GA, did graduate work in History at Columbia University in New York City, got a B.S. in Agriculture at the University of Georgia in Athens, and after her children were born, a Masters in Education at Auburn University.

She married Thomas Gilbert Butler on June 10, 1956 at Koinonia Farm, Americus, GA. She taught special education 27 years in Lexington (Lauderdale County) and Winfield City Schools. She was a member of Guin First Baptist Church. She taught Bible Classes for 82 years, and with her husband, volunteered in Christian Missions for 42 years, including more than 20 states in the US and every continent except Antarctica.

She is survived by her husband of 63 years, Thomas Gilbert Butler of Guin, AL, daughters Leanna Butler Salley (Dennis) of Hollandale, MS, and Marcie Butler of Concord, NC, son, Jed Butler ("Daughter-In-Love" Terry) of Columbus, GA, Grandchildren Katelynn Turner (Tyler), Kendyl Salley (Matt), David Salley, Collin Salley, Rowan Butler, Caleb O'Quinn, Cliff O'Quinn, and great-granddaughters Charlsie and Blakely Turner.
